Musikinstrumenten-Museum SIMPK

Information for Visitors

In accordance with the State of Berlin's Third SARS-Cov-2 (coronavirus) Infection Protection Measures Ordinance, the "2G" regulation will be in effect for visits to Musikinstrumenten-Museum SIMPK from Monday, 15 November 2021 until 28 November 2021 for the time being.

You need to wear an FFP2 or medical mask throughout your visit and also during events. This applies to all visitors aged 6 and over. Please bring your own mask. A medical certificate does not exempt you from the mask requirement.

You will need the following documents to access the museum:

- Your digital 2G proof, i.e.
 - the digital EU vaccination certificate
 - or the digital convalescence certificate of the EU
- Your valid photo ID

Only fully vaccinated or recovered persons with digitally verifiable EU certificates will be admitted to the Museum and the events, guided tours, workshops or concerts taking place there.

The 2G obligation does not apply to persons under 18 years of age or persons who cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons. They can also be tested negative (PCR or antigen rapid test. PCR test not older than 48 hours, rapid antigen test not older than 24 hours). Vaccination ineligibility must be proven with a medical certificate.

Instead of a test certificate, a student ID from Berlin or Brandenburg is sufficient for pupils.

Children up to 6 years of age are not subject to compulsory testing.

At events, guided tours, workshops or concerts, the attendance of visitors is documented.
